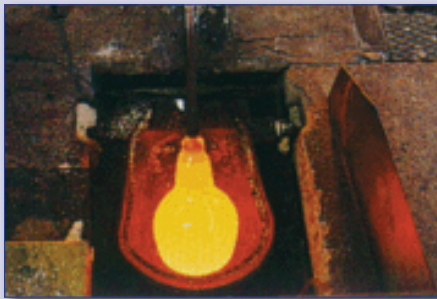

## Old World Colonial™

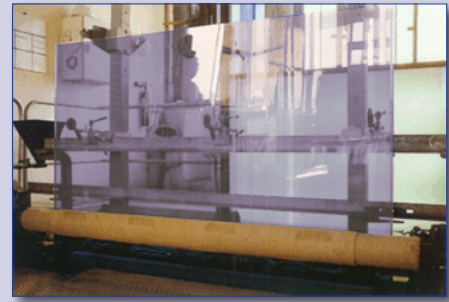

When period authenticity is not a requirement, yet the "old world" look is desired and economy is a consideration, **Retroverre™** is a clear choice. Made from a proprietary process that infuses tiny pits in the surface of a highly polished glass, **Retroverre™** conveys the illusion of old glass. **Retroverre™** offers the highest yield with its non directional distortion with the added advantage that the distortion is noticeable even in small pieces. Ideal for kitchen cabinet glass, old clocks, furniture, and lighting fixtures. Available in 3mm (1/8") thickness, **Retroverre™** can only be tempered in special circumstances by the manufacturer.
